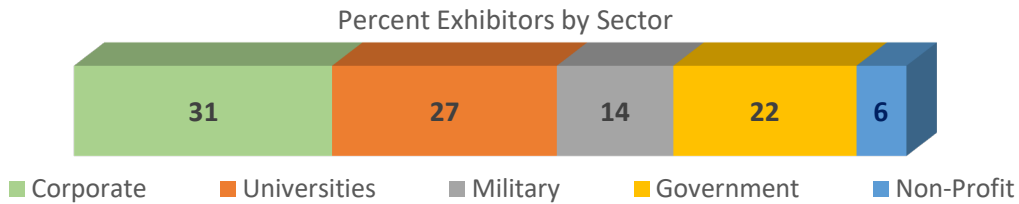

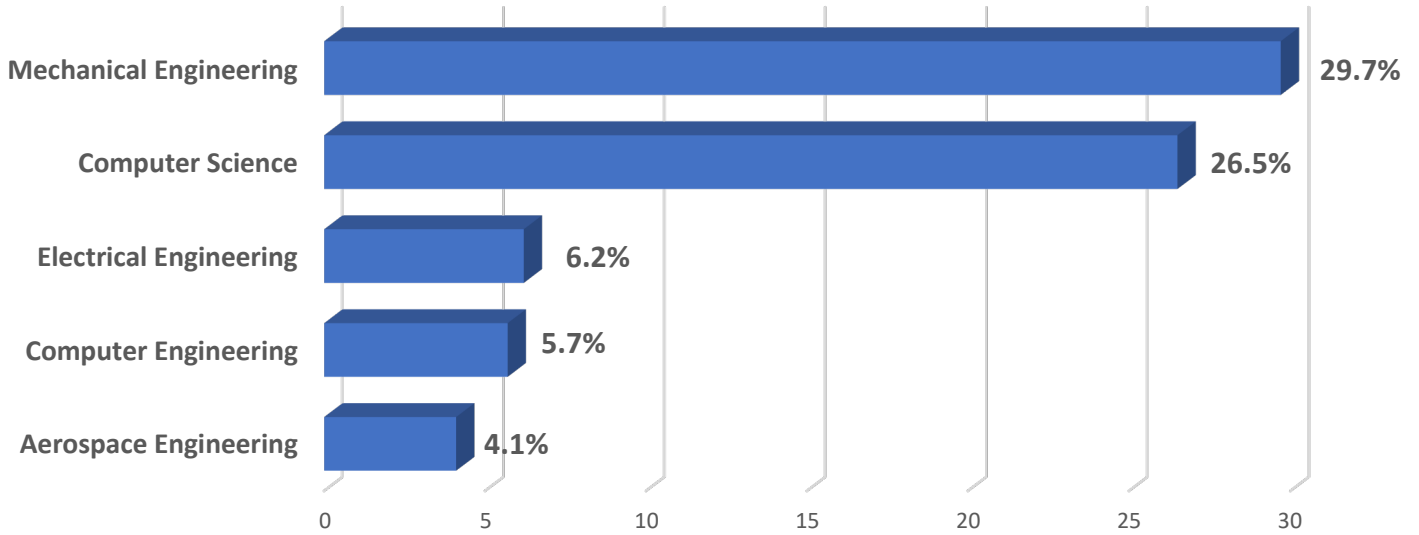

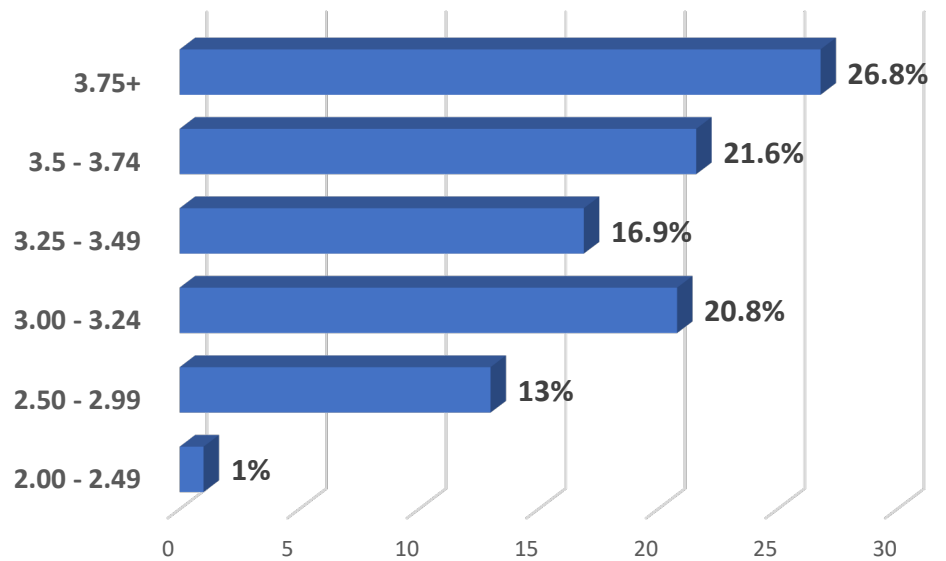

GMiS received over 1,200 completed applications for the GMiS STEM Scholarships, which offers both merit-based academic scholarships and STEM Civic Leadership Scholarships. This year, due to COVID-19, scholars were honored virtually at the Scholars Reception and the Student Leadership Awards.

By end of 2020, GMiS will have awarded over **\$5M** to more than **1,700** college students.

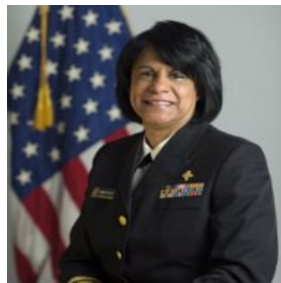

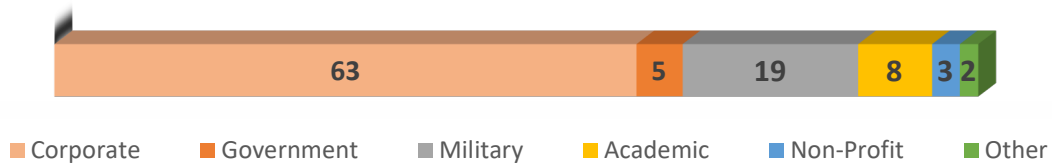

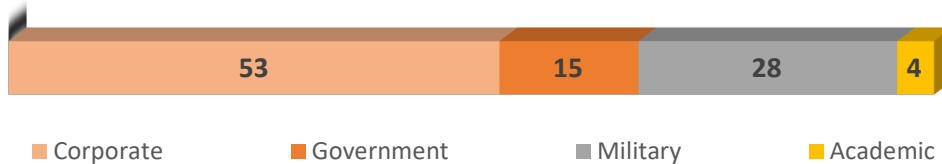
